Using That Brick Wall As A Foundation presented by

J. Mark Lowe, CG, FUGA

Do you ever feel like you are at a dead end? In genealogy, that is commonly referred to as a brick wall. By reviewing your research and taking a fresh approach, you often see new opportunities to find our ancestors. Learn how to use the very evidence that stops you in your tracks to spring over those brick walls.

J. Mark Lowe is a full-time professional genealogist, author, and teacher. He has published articles in the Association of Professional Genealogists Quarterly, North Carolina Genealogical Society Quarterly, Genealogical Speakers Guild Speak!, The Longhunter, and other society publications. Lowe's weekly local history articles appear in the Robertson County Times (Tennessee). He is also a director of the Regional In-depth Genealogical Alliance and is an instructor at the Institute of Genealogical and Historical Research and the Salt Lake Institute of Genealogy. Lowe's presentations are informative and very entertaining! You may have even seen him on the Lionel Richie segment of the television program Who Do You Think You Are.
