He has presented at the FGS National Conference in 1997 and 2004, and NGS Conference in 1994. John has also been the featured speaker for more than 70 all day seminars located in Texas, Louisiana, Arkansas, New Mexico, and Oklahoma.

HistoryGeo.com is a family history software service for linking old maps and land records to genealogy research. HistoryGeo is best known for its revolutionary First Landowners Project. Instead of looking at landowner maps township by township, the First Landowners Project is like having a single, INTERACTIVE MAP containing over 12+ million landowners among 30 states - all 29 of the public land states in the Continental U.S. plus Texas. FLP is constantly expanded map coverage along with the ability to keep track of all the early homesteaders you're researching. Please bring your laptop or other device and your research.
