HistoryGeo.com is a family history software service that links old maps and land records to genealogy research. HistoryGeo is best known for its revolutionary First Landowners Project. Instead of looking at landowner maps township by township, the <u>FLP</u> is like having a single, interactive map containing over 12+ million landowners among 30 states — all 29 of the public land states in the Continental U.S. plus Texas. FLP is constantly expanding map coverage and the ability to track all the early homesteaders you're researching. HistoryGeo is a free, online access through HPL! <u>Please bring your Houston Public</u> Library card, laptop or other device, and your research.

Find Your Ancestors in Cemeteries

Finding your ancestors can be more accessible than going to the cemetery; you can find them online in many places! With just a few pieces of information, you can track down the final resting places of your family members in a matter of minutes if you know a few genealogy secrets and tips. We'll discuss sites like Find A Grave, Billion Graves, the Nationwide Gravesite Locator, Internment.net, and JewishGen Online Worldwide Burial Registry. We'll also learn how to locate records on FamilySearch and other genealogy repositories. Please bring your laptop or other device and your research.



Teresa encouraged members to consider volunteering for either position!


